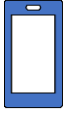




## Milbrook Elementary School Student Cell Phone Expectations 25-26



Students assume all risks of damage, theft, or loss when choosing to bring phones, wearables like Smartwatches, or headphones to school. All phones and wearable technology including headphones should be **OFF** and **AWAY** while in school.

Students will be able to put cell phones in classroom lock box. Teacher will return at the end of the day.



Cell phone use at Milbrook Elementary School is prohibited at all times. This includes bathrooms, lunch room, and the hallway.

Headphones are always prohibited in school unless they are wired headphones for a specific instructional purpose. No Bluetooth headphones are allowed to be worn at any time.



Students who utilize a personal device for medical needs or as part of a documented Individualized Education Plan (IEP) will be handled on an individual basis by the administrative team.



Parents will be notified via a Talking Points message home for each violation. This is a generic message, and questions should be directed to the Administrator or Teacher who assigned the violation.

### Consequences

1 <sup>st</sup> Violation	Single verbal warning – may be whole class OR individual
2 <sup>nd</sup> Violation	Issue Violation and Parent Contact – Teacher documents in FOCUS
3 <sup>rd</sup> Violation	Issue Violation – Teacher documents in FOCUS Administrative Consequences after 3 <sup>rd</sup> Violation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Required Parent Conference:</b> Review cell phone policy with parents, discuss student actions, make a contract for moving forward with additional infractions</li></ul>
